Please join the Tiger Bay Club on **Monday, April 17, 2017** when we host a very special guest – Florida Senator **Jack Latvala**. Senator Latvala is currently Chair of the powerful Senate Appropriations Committee which oversees the state budget and allocation of budget for Florida's upper Chamber. He is one of a few Floridians who has been returned by voters to the State Senate first serving from 1994-2002, and then returning in 2009 to the present when he was motivated to run again because the State House of Representatives voted to allow oil drilling within three miles of the Gulf beaches. Senator Latvala has been a resident of Florida for almost 50 years and represents Florida's 16th Senate District which includes multiple beach communities in Pinellas County. He also owns a car wash and home in Steinhatchee.

Senator Latvala has been in the forefront for the Florida Senate in its efforts to preserve both Visit Florida and Enterprise Florida, Inc. Florida House Speaker Richard Corcoran has made it a priority and in fact two bills have passed abolishing completely Enterprise Florida – Florida's Statewide Economic Development Agency, and significantly reducing the budget for Visit Florida – Florida's Tourism Marketing Agency. In addition, Senator Latvala is at the heart of beach protection and water issues. He is one of the most powerful and influential decision-makers in the Florida Legislature. Senator Latvala is

also strongly considering a run for the Republican Nomination for Florida's Governor in 2018.
