SHARYL ATTKISSON is the *New York Times* bestselling author of both *Smear* and *Stonewalled*, a five-time Emmy Award winner, and the host of Sinclair's national investigative television program *Full Measure with Sharyl Attkisson*. As a working journalist for more than thirty years, she has covered controversies under the administrations of Bill Clinton, George W. Bush, and Barack Obama, emerging with a reputation, as the *Washington Post* put it, as a "persistent voice of news-media skepticism about the government's story." She views herself as "politically agnostic," highly skeptical of those in power, and her former colleagues at CBS News nicknamed her "Pit Bull" because she gets on a story and will not let go. She is a recipient of the Edward R. Murrow Award for investigative reporting and has reported nationally and served as an anchor for CBS News, PBS, and CNN. One source states that "Attkisson believes that public and federal officials work for us, and that it's gotten to the point where they don't believe they should be accountable." In this independent vein, she is quoted – "I don't care what people think about my reporting."

Tiger Bay Pulls Back the Curtain . . .

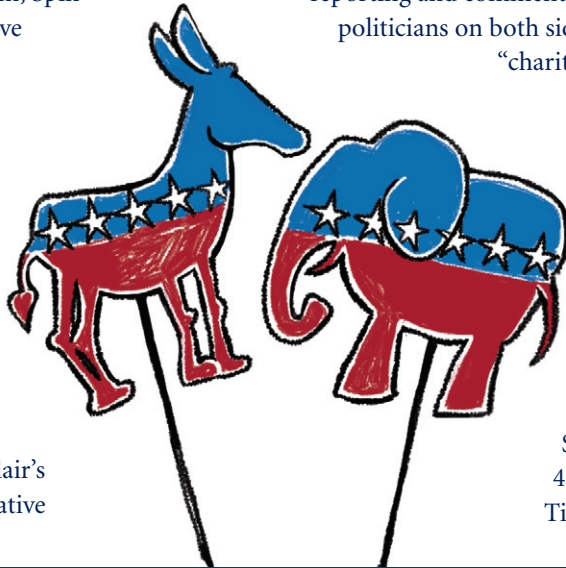

Attkisson's approach to her work may be spelled out in the self-description on her Twitter account: #Investigative Journalist. "Dreaming of a day when public officials answer questions as if they know they work for the public."

This event will use RESERVED SEATING for all attendees. Each member attends free of charge and is allowed to bring one guest free of charge. All efforts will be made to secure seating for members and the guests identified (*and paid for with the reservation*) on their reply cards.
